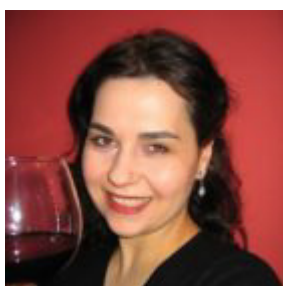


# R&A Pfaffl 2017 Reserve Golden Grüner Veltliner (Weinviertel)

The nose suggests very ripe fruit, full-blown yeastiness and wet earth. The palate adds bright, fresh lemon notes to this earthy, intense mix and presents a very textured, concentrated midpalate. This is a wine that needs hearty food to do its muscular structure justice.
